CASE OVERVIEW

A police officer in his mid-40s sustained severe injuries in a motor vehicle accident while responding to a call. This resulted in traumatic injuries, including a fractured pelvis and back issues.

Before FMCO became involved, the patient underwent ineffective spine surgery, nerve blocks, a spinal stimulator, and was prescribed dangerous narcotics—all without pain relief.



CHALLENGES TO SOLVE



Over-Treatment

Lack of a unified plan led to ineffective treatments from siloed providers.

Pain management providers used risky narcotics to address pain symptoms.

A municipal worker sustained lower-body injuries after stepping in a hole while raising a flag at work. FMCO started with physical therapy, but after two weeks of persistent pain, further testing revealed hip damage requiring replacement surgery.

The surgery was promptly scheduled and successfully performed within the FMCO network, but the patient continued to report back pain post-surgery.

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
